

Exploring the World

Through Music, Dance, and Stories



Each day we will travel to a different country, learning about the people who live there through their folktales, music, and folkdances. The class will begin with music and dancing, followed by a story, which the children can act out, taking turns playing the different characters. At our first meeting, I will ask each child what their own family's heritage is, so that I can include stories, music, and dances from every culture represented in our group.

Please note: this class has a minimum enrollment number of 3 students and a maximum capacity of 10 students.

Age Group:

- Rising 1st - Rising 3th

Dates:

- Monday, July 24th - Friday, July 28th

Time:

- Afternoon (12:15 - 3:00 p.m.)
 - This class can be paired with a morning class (9:00 - 11:45 a.m.) to create a full day (9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.)
 - Students staying for the full day will have a lunch break from 11:45 a.m. and 12:15 p.m.
 - Extended day options can be added on prior to the start of morning classes (8:00 - 9:00 a.m.) and/or after afternoon classes (3:00 - 4:00 p.m.) for an additional cost (see below)

Cost: (for the 5 days)

- Each half-day specialty camp program: \$250
- Morning or afternoon extended: \$80
- Morning and afternoon extended: \$150

Students will need:

- A packed lunch, if staying for the full day (we'll provide snack)
- A water bottle
