

Intro to Glass Art



In this week-long camp, young artists will learn the ancient art of glass fusing, stained glass, and sandblasting! This class requires no prior experience and is ideal for students who are curious about trying a new art form and love working with their hands. Students will be taught through demonstrations and hands-on instruction about different methods for cutting, working with and arranging glass. All students will be taught the basic building blocks of working with glass through specific projects including pendants, suncatchers, and sandblasted cups. Students will choose or create their own design and learn how to grind, shape, arrange, and solder their first stained glass piece. *Please note: this class has a minimum enrollment number of 10 students and a maximum capacity of 20 students.*

Age Group:

- Rising 4th/5th

Dates:

- Monday, July 10th - Friday, July 14th

Time:

- Afternoon (12:15 - 3:00 p.m.)
 - This class can be paired with a morning class (9:00 - 11:45 a.m.) to create a full day (9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.)
 - Students staying for the full day will have a lunch break from 11:45 a.m. and 12:15 p.m.
 - Extended day options can be added on prior to the start of morning classes (8:00 - 9:00 a.m.) and/or after afternoon classes (3:00 - 4:00 p.m.) for an additional cost (see below)

Cost: (for the 5 days)

- Each half-day specialty camp program: \$250
- Morning or afternoon extended: \$80
- Morning and afternoon extended: \$150

Students will need:

- A packed lunch, if staying for the full day (we'll provide snack)
