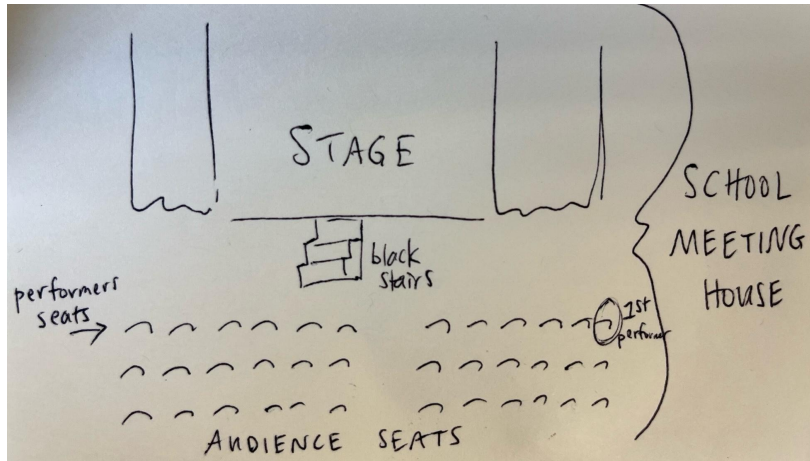




Brookwood Recitals are a cherished tradition and a wonderful way to share music with our community. Use the following information to prepare your students for success!

Students who are performing in recital will sit in the front row. There will be a seat marked with their name. Performance order will begin from Stage Left.



Each student will walk up the black stairs, announce their name and what they will be playing, then go to the appropriate spot on stage and perform.

Once the performance is over, they will stand, pause, bow or curtsy and then walk down the black stairs and return to their seat.

It is essential to practice these steps with your students. Walk them through every part and even take them to the School Meeting house during lesson time to get a feel for the room and for being on stage.

All pieces are limited to a maximum of 2 minutes.
